Dear Praying Friends,

I bring greetings to you once again from Kenya, Africa. I hope that you are doing fine in your areas of the harvest field. This is another time that I am excited to report to you of what God has been doing with us in the ministry. This has been one of the busiest months of all for us because we had a lot of activities and church programs going on. Maureen is so excited to be back at church after several weeks of maternity leave. Our son, Wendell, is healthy and growing so fast. He is becoming a night owl though and does not go to bed sometimes until



3:30 AM.

As I had reported to you earlier, our youth ministry is doing very well since Sister Martha started working with them. They were able to appoint their leaders and the church prayed for them at our service last Sunday. Sister Martha is an answer to my prayers. I've been trusting God for several years to send someone who would work with our young people, someone who was committed and dedicated. We have already seen that in Sister Martha. The youth have already started thinking about some projects that could be initiated to generate income to sustain them, their church and their families in the future.

Also, the women are meeting every Wednesday and are coming up with their own projects as well. They have started contributing to a small fund in order to start a soap production business and try to sell the products to schools, hospitals and churches. It is really encouraging to see how God is working through the lives of our church members. They are coming up with all these ideas showing that they are up for self sustainability and a brighter future. The church is requesting your prayers that God would provide some funds to jump start all these intended projects. We can be supported with \$1500 for these two groups. You can help make a very big difference and create a source of livelihood amongst our people.

We are still trusting God for the shipping of our remaining three crates with equipment. Whenever they arrive, we will be ready to hit the roads and reach many with the Love of Jesus. The girls are doing fine and are in school. Paul's leg was badly injured by a sharp nail while playing at school. We found



that one of the boys in the house has been stealing from us. We lost one box speaker, but recovered it yesterday when he was trying to get someone to buy it at a throwaway price. Please pray that God would change and work on his heart and bring him to the place that he may know what he did wasn't a godly thing and repent!.

Please remember to keep praying for our Sunday school kids. It's so amazing to see these little kids waking up so early on Sunday morning to attend some classes at the church. Glenda leads her kids every Sunday morning. We are blessed to see what God is doing because it's something that I missed when I was their age and nobody was there to show me the way.

In closing, I would love to thank you all for your prayers and support because without your support we would not be here touching as many lives as we can with the Love of Christ. We love you all.
