God intervened and we saw both parties dropping their stand and resolve to a Grand Coalition Government whereby power is equally shared between the Government side and the opposition.

Everything is now getting back to normal; churches are slowly catching up because most of the members were badly affected. Our Kapterit Church was badly affected as the result of the Pokots coming in to drive away cattle and killing innocent people.

provide so that we can get it fixed as it is impossible for us to do our outreaches as usual without the generator which is the only source of power in the villages where there's no power supply.

Last Week I traveled and ministered in Kampala which is the Capital of Uganda, A pastor friend invited me as the co-guest speaker and the power of God moved in the meetings like never before. Many people were healed and delivered by the power of God.



Maureen and I started a small barber and salon business in town whereby when am outside there ministering, Maureen takes care of the shop. We are trying hard to work and get some funds which can assist us to keep the girls that we are supporting for we are not sure of adequate financial support from the well wishers. By doing so we hope that God will be well pleased when we can also work with our own hands to support our Family. Kindly pray that God would provide with the three needed Barber chairs and some other things for the Salon.
