Last year we had in Romania pastor Bolanta from Nigeria. He is pastoring a very large church in Nigeria. He came and God used him in a powerful way in Romania for healings and evangelism. He also has a gift of prophecy. He had a word of prophecy for me and my wife telling us that God will do great things through our SOS Church. Also he said that he saw by vision that me and my wife were involved in teens camps. In December last year we have remembered the prophecy and decided to organize a small motivational camp for two days in Sinaia for youth.
