Dear Friends.

I bring greetings to you all from Kenya, Africa hoping that you are doing fine in your areas of the harvest field. Back here we are doing fine and the Lord has been good to us.

I am glad to report to you about our recent outreaches to the villages here in Kenya...

Last Sunday the 2nd of Dec 2007 was the last day of our Crusade in the Baraka area where we had an ordination service for two of our Pastors who are in charge of the two new churches that we planted in different villages. It was a very exciting moment as we had fellowship with our Brothers and Sisters in the Lord.

Many attended the crusade even though they had to arrive at the venue in late hours after attending to their different duties during the day. We had a very good attendance at the crusade and 342 people gave their lives to Jesus Christ during the invitation. 76 people among those who accepted Christ in our first two days of the Crusade showed the interest of getting Baptism and thus we had to take them through the Baptism classes to prepare them for the Baptism which was coming ahead on Sunday.



Sunday Morning we started by ordaining our two Pastors, Pastor John W. Manana of Baraka Church and Pastor Peter O. Etyang of Kapterit Church. The two had invited friends and pastors of other local churches and relatives to witness their Ordination of which I presented them with certificates from HMI.

It was an amazing service. We had our service under our Crusade stage! When I was designing this stage I never knew at that time it may serve as a place of



where many people can sit under and have a church service like inside any other church sanctuary! When you see the pictures, then you will be able to see that we are having our service under the crusade stage. During the Ordination service the two pastors and their wives knelt at the front and pastors who had come from other churches and our church leaders gathered around them and stretched hands towards them as I prayed.

After the Ordination it was the time to fellowship at the Lords table and I am glad that almost all of us shared in the Holy Communion.

Now, the time had come for the Baptism and we had to find a suitable place or water for those who had showed interest of being baptized to be immersed. We loaded all the 76 inside the tractor that belongs to Gedion who is our church member. The tractor was the only means that we could have at the moment to ferry people to the Baptism venue. Our ministry car was also used to transport women and Children while Simon one of our church young people was driving it.



We really thank God for the vehicle which we purchased through the support of HMI. Now we are trusting God for new tires because since we started these meetings we have had more than 20 flat tires in 5 days only because the tires are worn out completely due to our roads which are in a very bad shape. On Thursday as we were transporting some equipment to the meetings venue, there was a heavy tire burst which scared everyone at the place, but am glad that I was able to control the car and stopped safely. The guardian angel was fully at work. All that I can say is that the meeting was very successful though the enemy tried as much as he could to stop us. But we thank God that many lives were touched and many received deliverance in the meeting.



Please continue praying for us and especially pray to support us financially so that we may reach many people with the Good news. We have the passion to reach as many people as we can, but the only thing that keeps us from doing so is the financial arm of the ministry. Like in this recent meeting I really struggled to make sure that we still had the meeting because we did not have the needed funds to feed our Crusade team but am glad that God

provided for us the little that we had. Our young people camped in the village for 5 days prior for the meetings, doing some house to house evangelism and by leading so many peoples lives to Jesus while at their respective homes.

I deeply thank you for your prayers and support because without you all we could not be doing all that we are doing here reaching the lost with the good news!
