We had one of the prayer partners ask us to make an estimate of what it would cost to finished just the outside of the building including the roof First Floor (Basement)

- 3 windows -----\$250.

Second Floor

- 11 windows-----\$1600
- one door-----\$120.
- brick wall-----\$75. (It is almost complete)

Third Floor

- front glass window-----\$1000.
- 12 windows-----\$1600
- brick wall-----\$950.

Fourth Floor

- front glass window-----\$1000
- glass cross-----\$1000
(It goes from Third floor to the roof)
- 25 windows-----\$2500
- cement for floor-----\$1500
- 20 columns to roof-----\$3800
- brick wall-----\$1600

Roof estimate: -----\$7000

Rough estimate-----\$24,000 (no labor included) but they have been paying the workers (Pastor and his sons) out of the church money (BRCC).

Larry and I feel that for warmth for this coming winter that this is what would be needed: Completion of the first and second floor. To get the roof on, they would probably need the fourth floor columns but glass and the other cost could wait until the following year. The first floor would remain the church for now and the second floor for the family to sleep.



When completed, the basement will be used for classrooms and assembly rooms for the children. This is also where they will practice music and dance and evangelize. 2nd floor: The Pastor's home. 3rd floor: The church office and more classrooms. 4 th floor: Will be the new church worship area.

The 4th floor is finally ready for the concrete to be poured. It took over 3 weeks to get the concrete girders in place, the foam forms (to take up space so less concrete is needed) inserted between the girders, the rebar laid on top of the foam and wired together, the wiring for lights and Internet completed, and braces underneath the whole 4th floor to hold the weight of the concrete until it hardens.

The concrete will be delivered and poured on Monday, the 15th. It took a week just to get the concrete company to come and give them an estimate and another week now before they can deliver!! This is the work that was in process and needed to be completed when we arrived in Sept. Work can now begin to complete the first floor (basement) and second floors and have them ready before winter comes (April, the seasons are reversed here).

While Larry is working on the building, I have been preparing lessons, and helping with making crafts to sell. The money will go for evangelizing. Also I have been going over to Miky's house and helping Tech and Noemi make clothes for the street children. Very busy but very blessed.
