

SOS Church Report September 2009

Dear Friends,

I hope this report will find you doing very well. I would like to share with you about our I Believe Camp Sinaia 2009. This past summer, we prayed and sought God's wisdom and understanding about what He wants us to do to evangelize. Our leadership team met in my office, we prayed and discussed about new ministry ideas. We also prayed for wisdom on how to touch the lives of the unchristian teenagers. In that meeting we brainstormed and decided to organize a youth camp in Sinaia. We paid a very good price for 3 days. With 700 US Dollars, we booked a 34 bed chalet in Sinaia.



I have challenged every participant who registers to bring an unchristian friend. So, we had 10 unchristian youth in the camp. For them, it was the first event like this that they had attended. We established four sessions in 3 days, September 25-27. The schedule contained praise, drama, strong testimonies and video projections. The program was so appealing and we were able to mix some free time between sessions. For testimonies, we had brother Gigi from Campina. He used to be a dangerous gangster and a robber that was in prison a few times. Also, I had a fellow pastor from Campina who experienced two major car accidents. One young couple from SOS Church testified about God's love in their life and how they decided to follow Christ. They were baptized earlier this year.

Paula testified how God restored her after she was abused during her childhood. Now she is involved in counseling the victims of domestic violence. Their strong testimonies had a powerful impact over the audience. Sunday morning, during the last session, I made a public calling to receive Jesus. Seven of them received Jesus in their life for their very first time. We saw on their faces a lot of joy and happiness. Praise the Lord!! Our team is involved with following up with them now.





After the camp, we realized that taking unchristian people out of their environment made a great impact on them. This idea gave us a very creative way to present the Gospel to them. I will finish this report by asking you to pray for Romania and for God to reveal to us new and creative ideas for touching the lives of the Romanian people.
